PGE Lightning Dismissal

Douglas County School District encourages individual schools to use the Weather Bug app to monitor severe weather. Pine Grove follows the District guidelines that state if lightning is within a 6-mile radius from our building at dismissal, we are to hold students in their classrooms until a parent or an adult listed as an emergency contact either picks them up or until the lightning has passed. If the lightning is beyond the 6 mile radius and it is prior to 3:30 pm, we will return to a regular dismissal procedure at that time.

When a red flag day is called, we make a school wide announcement, and if time allows, we post it on the marquee, raise red flags outside and send an email to parents. Oftentimes, we call a red flag dismissal right at 3:10 pm and we are unable to send the emails right away.

Per DCSD policy, siblings younger than 18 are not authorized to pick up younger siblings from a building during inclement weather.

Red flags located at these locations indicate a LIGHTNING DISMISSAL:

- On the flagpole by the main entrance.
- By the kindergarten playground northwest of the building.
- By the third/fourth grade entrance northeast of the building.
