- Welcome and Introductions
- Principal Update
 - Update on School funding
 - Overview of school funding – MLO & Bond will be on November ballot
 - Discussed where schools are currently receiving funding, how this bond would benefit the school, and how this would be spent without deviation
 - Unified Improvement Plan
 - Requirement of state and federal
 - Reflect on past UIP and set targets for improvements. Due to gaps in CMAS analysis due to COVID, other tests and strategies were analyzed for a conclusion including iready; school performance framework completed last in 2019 so hard to compare;

- Discussed future education about why participating in CMAS is important for the school
- Overall performance challenge conclusion:
 - Root cause – testing apathy, lack of consistent instructional approach in ELA, lack of consistent common formative assessments
 - Action plan – develop authentic data culture; all teachers participate in discussion and analysis of student data (weekly PLC time)
 - Next steps for UIP – review with SAC, leadership team, staff, and due to CDE mid October
- Teacher Update
 - Specials plus (tech, social/emotional, library) extra 30 minutes 3x week time for teachers to focus on formative assessment on kids needs and come up with plan for classes or grade level – contributes to PLC time and UIP goals
 - Informed us of advanced reading program
- Discuss possible internet education night
 - Focus on internet safety – committee agrees to this and Ryan is taking a lead on organizing speakers/dates. Aiming for November meeting and possibly inviting other elementary schools
